

Straight and Narrow™

Syzygium australe 'SAN01' (l)

NATIVE SHRUBS & GROUNDCOVERS

Psyllid resistant Lilly Pilly that is naturally very narrow.

- Straight and Narrow™ *Syzygium* provides sculptured design for tight planting spaces.
- A very slender, semi-compact and dense Lilly Pilly.
- For screening and hedging in sun or shade.
- It has tight attractive leaves and white flowers that proceeds to beautiful red/pink fruit.
- The Straight and Narrow™ plant grows 5–8m tall and can be pruned down to 2m.

Description	Slender, semi-compact Lilly Pilly
Density	1 plant per 1–2m ² 1–1.5 per liner metre
Height & Width	5–8m x 1–1.5m
Flowering	White duster flowers from Nov–Dec
Best Planting Time	March–November
Uses	Perfect for constricted planting areas (fences and driveways), works well for topiary
Position	Full sun to shade Tolerates cold and dry
Soil Type	Suits moist, well drained soils
Care	Natural Psyllid resistance makes it unlikely to have this problem. Water as required for 8–13 weeks until established. Plant in a well mulched garden (chunky mulch is recommended). If required use slow release fertiliser in spring. Prune twice yearly for a very tidy hedge or every 2–3 years as a wider screen plant.
