NATIVE SHRUBS & GROUND COVERS

This Callistemon produces masses of dark pink flowers bottle brush in spring.

- Candy Burst™ Callistemon is a semi-compact fine leaf Callistemon that is great as a feature plant or for mass planting and hedging.
- Its gorgeous dark pink flowers add a gentle burst of colour in Spring, and contrast beautifully with its dark green foliage.
- It has good frost and drought tolerance once established, and will tolerate full sun to partly shaded positions.
- Great for attracting bees and native birds.
- It is a low maintenance Callistemon that requires little to no pruning to maintain a tidy form, but can be pruned yearly to encourage a denser habit.



Description	Semi-compact Callistemon with dark pink flowers
Density	1-3 plants per m ² 1-2 per linear metre
Height & Width	1-1.2m x 1-1.2m
Flowering	Dark pink flowers in spring
Best Planting Time	March-October
Uses	Hedges, mass planting, feature plant, specimen planting and contrast planting
Position	Full sun to part shade
Soil Type	Most soil types
Care	Water as required for 8-13 weeks until established. Plant in a well mulched garden (chunky mulch is recommended). If required use slow release fertiliser in spring. If ever required, prune every 3-4 years for a natural shape, or every 2 years for a tidy hedge.
Where it Works	NSW, VIC, Sth QLD, SA & WA (more testing required for Nth QLD & ACT)
