


NATIVE SHRUBS & GROUND COVERS

Naturally narrow growing Callistemon with vibrant white bottle brush flowers.

- Icy Burst[™] Callistemon is a naturally narrow growing fine leaf Callistemon.
- It has a narrow upright growth habit and a compact height making it a excellent choice for tight planting areas.
- It produces vibrant white flowers in Spring that contrast beautifully with its dark green foliage.
- It has good frost and drought tolerance once established, and will tolerate full sun to partly shaded positions.
- Great for attracting bees and native birds.
- It is a low maintenance Callistemon that requires little to no pruning to maintain its narrow upright form, but can be pruned yearly to encourage a denser habit.

Description	Naturally narrow growing Callistemon with vibrant white flowers
Density	1–3 plants per m² 1–2 per linear metre
Height & Width	1.3-1.5m x 70-80cm
Flowering	White flowers in spring
Best Planting Time	March-October
Uses	Hedges, mass planting, feature plant, specimen planting
Position	Full sun to part shade
Soil Type	Most soil types
Care	Water as required for 8-13 weeks until established. Plant in a well mulched garden (chunky mulch is recommended). If required use slow release fertiliser in spring. If ever required, prune every 3-4 years for a natural shape, or every 2 years for a tidy hedge.
Where it Works	NSW, VIC, Sth QLD, SA & WA (more testing required for Nth QLD & ACT)
