Soil Type	Tolerates most soils, but avoid consistently wet areas
Care	Water as required for 8-13 weeks until established; plant in well-mulched soil
Where it Works	ACT, VIC, SA, WA, TAS, NSW (south of Coffs Harbour), handles Sydney's humidity but not Queensland's
